# St Peter's PSA Lottery RULES

#### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of the St Peter's PSA Lottery is to raise funds for the school. The money will be paid into the PSA bank account and used to meet funding requests from the school, providing equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils.

#### **RULES**

- 1. For a cost of £2.50 you will be allocated one number. Your numbers will be advised to you in writing at the start of your membership, and you will become a member of the lottery.
- 2. The draw will be made in the last week of every term unless unforeseen events make the usual draw process impossible.
- 3. The prizes will total 50% of the accumulated fund since the last draw, with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize. This will be apportioned as: 1st prize of 25%, 2nd prize of 15% and 3rd prize of 10% of the accumulated fund for each termly draw. There will be no roll over.
- 4. The St Peter's School PSA Lottery is a small society lottery and is open to all parents, carers, staff and friends of St Peter's School, St Albans. Anyone age 16 or over can join.
- 5. Numbers are limited to two lottery numbers per child attending the school (Nursery to Year 6).
- 6. Payments must be made by monthly standing order.
- 7. Lottery number fees must be paid to the society before entry into the draw is allowed. To qualify for entrance into the termly draw, entrants must have paid into the lottery for each of the payment due dates relating to that term.
- 8. To leave the lottery notice must be given one month before your final payment for your last termly draw; this is before November 15<sup>th</sup> for the Christmas term draw, 15<sup>th</sup> February for the Easter term draw and 15<sup>th</sup> June for the Summer term draw.
- 9. Entrants leaving the lottery and ceasing payment midway through the term, forfeit their entry into that termly draw and monies paid in relation to that termly draw will be refunded.
- 10. For the avoidance of doubt, member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
- 11. The first draw was Christmas 2018.
- 12. The draw shall be made by the administrators in the presence of a PSA committee member during the last week of each term. The date will be notified via the school newsletter and PSA Facebook page or, in exceptional circumstances, via the school gateway messaging system.
- 13. The winning cheques should be collected from the school office. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into PSA funds after six months.
- 14. The name and numbers for each term's winners will be posted in the school newsletter and the PSA Facebook page.
- 15. The small society lottery will be run by the administrators (Anita Cornmell (Promotor) and Melanie Dass). In case of any dispute the decision of the administrators is final.
